Purpose and legal basis

1. Your personal data will only be processed for registration in the context of the event

The data will be processed in accordance with the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation (DSGVO), the Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG-neu) and other relevant data protection regulations. The processing and use of the individual data is necessary for the following purposes:

2. Pass Visitor's Service to allow you to enter our Facilities

The legal basis for this processing is **Art. 6 para. 1 lit. f GDPR**. Processing operations are based on this legal basis if the processing is necessary to safeguard a legitimate interest of our company, provided that your interests, fundamental rights and freedoms do not prevail. Art. 6 para. 1 lit. f GDPR is also relevant in connection with the Atomic Energy Act, requirements of the nuclear supervisory authority and the "Requirements for object safety in nuclear facilities and installations"/„Anforderungen an die Objektsicherheit in kerntechnischen Anlagen und Einrichtungen“. If the processing of personal data is necessary for the fulfilment of a contract or a pre-contractual measure, then Art. 6 para. 1 lit. b GDPR is the legal basis.

Storage period

Your rights
