Jülich Scientists have moved into their branch lab at the FRM-II research reactor in Munich. In total, 30 staff members from Research Centre Jülich are now working and conducting research in Garching near Munich. They are setting up and looking after the seven measuring instruments that were previously located in Jülich and are worth around Eur 45 million.
