If you have some time in Bonn and would like to visit an interesting exhibition, here are two suggestions:

- **Deutsches Museum Bonn:**
Topic: Research and Technology in Germany after 1945
Opening hours: Tuesday through Sunday 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
Admission: 4 Euro, children and teenagers from 6 to 16 years 2.50 Euro

- **Wunderkammer Wissenschaft (Science: A Chamber of Curiosities):**
Topic: Presentation of all 15 research centers in the Helmholtz association
Opening hours: Monday to Friday between 8 am to 7 pm
Admission: free of charge

Both exhibitions are located in the 'Wissenschaftszentrum', Ahrstrasse 45, 53175 Bonn

From Bad Honnef it takes around 1 hour. There is not direct tram connection, but you have to change trams at 'Bonn Hauptbahnhof':

From Bad Honnef to 'Bonn Hauptbahnhof': Tram 66, direction: Siegburg

From 'Bonn Hauptbahnhof' to 'Hochkreuz/Deutsches Museum Bonn': Tram 16 or 63, direction: Bad Godesberg Stadthalle

It takes around 10 min to walk from the tram station 'Hochkreuz/Deutsches Museum Bonn' to the 'Wissenschaftszentrum':

From the tram station 'Hochkreuz/Deutsches Museum Bonn' (A) you just have to follow the Kennedyallee to the Ahrstraße (B):
